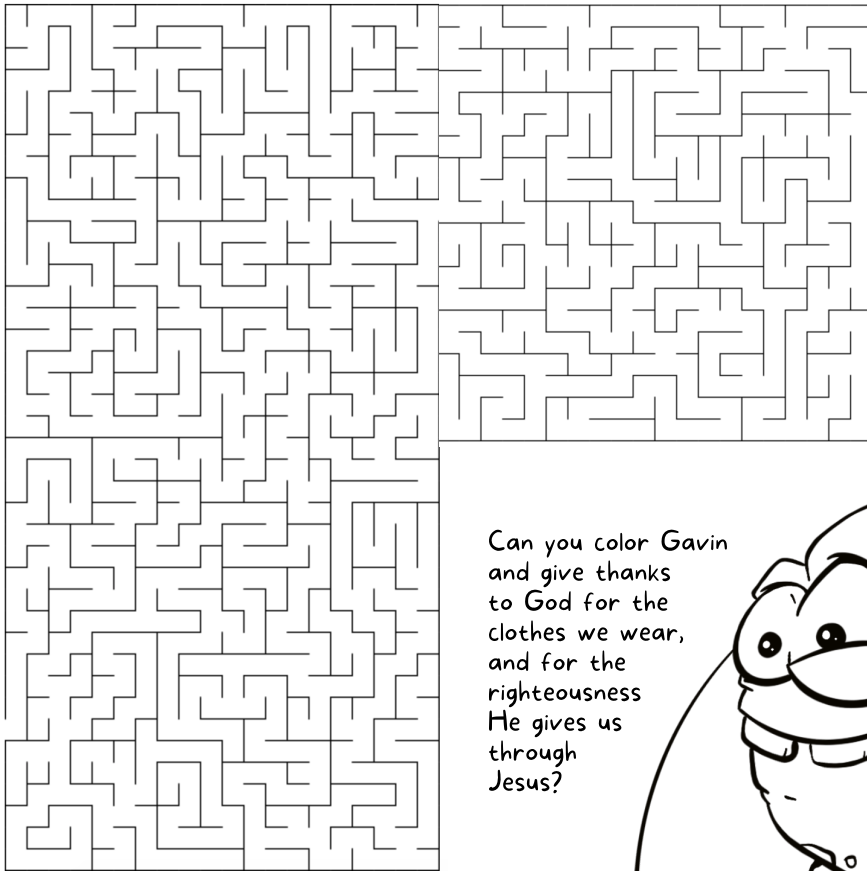


Bible Lessons

- John 6:41 (ESV)

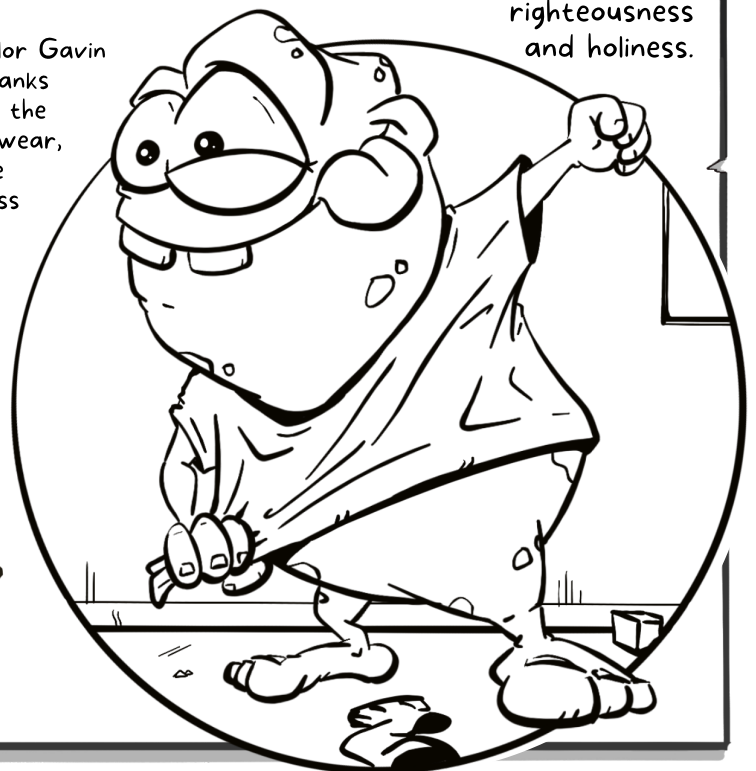
In our readings this Sunday we read of God providing for His prophet Elijah, Saint Paul encourages us to walk in love, and Jesus proclaims that He is the bread of life.
