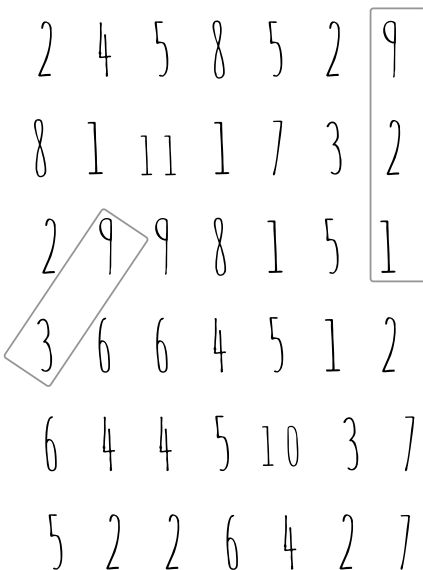


Bible Lessons

"Finding 12"

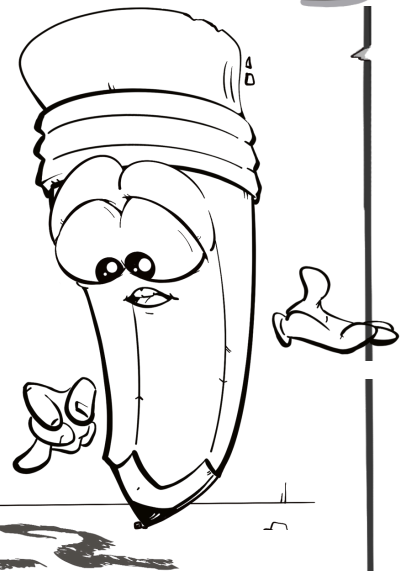
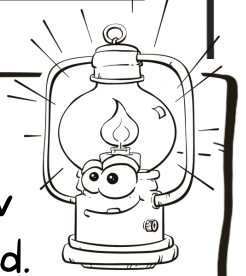


With the group of numbers on the left find and circle groups of numbers that add up to 12.

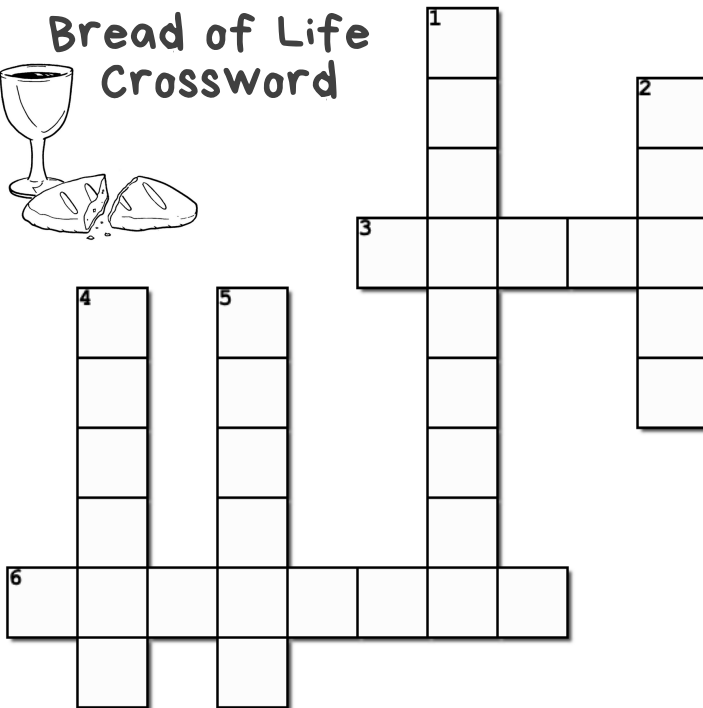
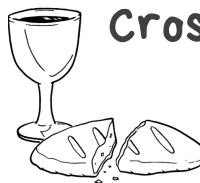

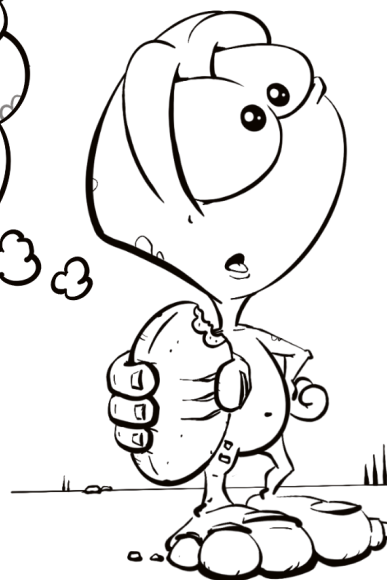
"Look carefully then how you walk, not as unwise but as wise,"
