Monday

Pray:

Read: Genesis 2:15-18

Think about the following:

- 1) What was God's purpose for creating man?
- 2) What was the warning the God gave Adam?
- 3) Was death part of God's original plan?

Prayer: Heavenly Father, thank you for creating us to look after your creation. Death wasn't part of your original plan, but thank you for sending Jesus to once again give us eternal life. In Jesus' name, amen.

Tuesday

Pray:

Read: Genesis 3:1-3

Think about the following:

- 1) What did the serpent say to the woman?
- 2) What is the serpent trying to do here?
- 3) How did the woman change God's original words?
- 4) How does Satan "sow seeds of doubt" in us today?

Prayer: Heavenly Father, you tell us that "Satan prowls like a roaring lion". Help us to see his lies and guard our hearts by staying close to you. In Jesus name, amen.



Wednesday

Pray:

Read: Genesis 3:4-6

Think about the following:

- 1) How did the serpent twist God's words?
- 2) What was so pleasing about the fruit (temptation)?
- 3) What temptations to go against God do we face today?

Prayer: Heavenly Father, we face so many temptations today. Often we fall into sin because of them. This is our fault, and we are truly sorry for our sins. Forgive us and give us the strength we need to follow your will. In Jesus name, amen.

Thursday

Pray:

Read: Genesis 3:7-10

Think about the following:

- 1) What happened when they ate the fruit?
- 2) What did they do when they heard God?
- 3) Why were they afraid?
- 4) How do you "hide from God"?

Prayer: Heavenly Father, because of our sin we are afraid to confess our sins to you. Help us to remember that we can't hide from you. Help us also to remember that you sent your son to die on a cross so that we don't have to fear you! In Jesus name, amen.

Friday

Pray:

Read: Genesis 3:11-19

Think about the following:

- 1) Notice how the man and woman "pass the buck"!
- 2) How do we pass the buck today?
- 3) What punishment did God give to all involved?
- 4) Notice the first promise of our saviour in verse 15.

Prayer: Heavenly Father, although Adam and Eve did not listen to your warning, you still showed your love for us by sending us Jesus to be our Saviour. In His name we pray, amen.

Saturday

Pray:

Read: Luke 19:10

Think about the following:

- 1) What did Jesus say is His purpose?
- 2) How did Jesus live out his purpose *then*?
- 3) How does Jesus use us today to "seek and save the lost"?

Prayer: Heavenly Father, you sent Jesus to seek and save us! Thank you for this wonderful gift that you give to us freely. Help us now to go out and share the Good News of this great gift with our neighbours, because you love them to and want them to come to saving faith in you. In Jesus name, amen.
